F101 Pedigree Questions, version 09/24/10 (A)

INSTRUCTIONS: We'll start by drawing a family tree. Then we have some questions about your medical history and the medical history of your relatives. Let's begin.

NOTE: IF RELATIVE IS DECEASED, USE PAST TENSE TEXT INCLUDED.

1. Is this relative alive? **IF DECEASED, SKIP TO b.**
 - a. How old is he/she? **SKIP TO #2.**
 - b. How old was he/she when he/she died?
 - c. What was the cause of his/her death?
2. Was this relative born with a heart problem or heart defect? Or, was this relative diagnosed with a heart problem when he/she was under 30 yrs old?
 - a. **IF YES TO EITHER:** What heart problem or heart defect does/*did* he/she have? Any other heart problems or defects? (REFER TO THE CARDIAC CODE LIST)
3. Does/*Did* this relative have any other birth defect, such as cleft lip or palate or spina bifida?
 - a. **IF YES:** What birth defect does/*did* he/she have? Any others? (REFER TO THE BIRTH DEFECT CODE LIST)
4. Does/*Did* this relative have a genetic disorder such as Down syndrome?
 - a. **IF YES:** What condition does/*did* he/she have? Any others? (REFER TO THE IDENTIFIED GENETIC SYNDROMES CODE LIST)
5. Does/*Did* this relative have developmental problems (for example, delays in learning to sit, walk, or talk), learning disabilities or attend special school?
 - a. **IF YES:** Was there a diagnosis? What was the diagnosis? Any others? (REFER TO THE DEVELOPMENTAL DELAY/LEARNING DISABILITY CODE LIST)

NOTE: IF RELATIVE IS SUBJECT'S MOTHER ASK #6; OTHERWISE PROCEED TO NEXT RELATIVE

6. Are you and your (*Are/Were the mother and the*) child's biological father related by blood?
 - a. **IF YES:** What is your (*What is their/What was their*) relationship? (REFER TO THE FAMILY MEMBER CODE LIST)
